He's said it is part of his mindfulness routine and could be his "secret weapon." Projects he's been working on in Tokyo have included a dog sweater and a little pouch for his hardwon gold medal.

tion with a knitting theme, as well — novels like Purl up and Die and others in the Knitting Mystery series by Maggie Sefton.

But finally, let's circle back to the growing number of men like Olympic diver Tom Daley, who

knit, and take a look at T. S. Easton's YA novel Boys Don't Knit: in Public, which tells the story of 17-year-old Ben Fletcher, who takes up knitting and finds that it helps with his anxiety and worry... but he deals with the pressure of hiding it from his friends. Or for adults, try Real Men Knit by K. M. Jackson, about four brothers struggling to keep a Harlem knitting shop open.

If you are ready to join a group of other knitters who knit, and help one another knit — right out in public! — come on down to the Library for Fiber and Friends.
