Kids age 12 and under can beat the boredom with weekly performances by different children's entertainers beginning with Magician Oscar Munoz, who headlines the June 2 kick-off party.

The summer roster includes musician Staci Gray, Safari Greg, Ventriloquist Nancy and Friends, Terrence Taps the Tap Dancer, Silly Sparkles and Dinosaur George.

Recording artist Joe McDermott, described as "a wizard" when it comes to his ability to communicate with children through music, wraps up the summer fun at the July 24 finale.

Events are free, but due to limited space, tickets will be issued first come, first served beginning one hour before each performance.

Due to popularity, the library is no longer able to accommodate large groups such as camps and daycares.

At 1 p.m. on most Wednesdays and Fridays throughout the summer, the library offers teens ages 9 to 12 additional programs ranging from making their own musical instruments to solving a mystery on Bluebeard's Pirate Ship to the always-popular Austin Reptile Show, just to name a few.

The July 27 finale features a Glow in the Dark Party complete with black lights and glowing slime.
